**Brisbane Campus [On Queen St. Mall - Level 3, Suite 316/180 Queen St., Brisbane] Subjects:**

**[ ] A Prophetic People – PM 203 (1.5 credits)**

Term 1, Monday Night Brisbane (7:00-8:00pm), 8 weeks (begins 31 Jan)

Come on a journey with us as we explore the prophetic nature of God's people. Ephesians says the church is built on "the foundation of apostles and prophets" (Eph. 2:20). What does that exactly mean? What is authentic prophetic ministry? In this subject we will explore these questions and also learn how to hear from God, receive prophetic insight and prophesy. You will be activated in the prophetic gifts and discover how the prophetic gifts operate in and through the God's people. Moreover, we will study the call of prophets and how their ministry will revolutionise your life, church and ministry.

**[ ] The Apostolic Church – TH 201 (1.5 credits)**

Term 1, Monday Night Brisbane (8:15-9:15pm), 8 weeks (begins 31 Jan)

The true church is apostolic. But what does this mean? In this subject, we will discover what is the apostolic foundation of the church. We will learn what the apostolic church looks like and how to fulfil this high calling. Students will understand the ministry of the apostle and learn to work with them for the furtherance of the kingdom. These sessions will impart the apostolic spirit and nature that was evident in the early church. If God is calling you to minister, this subject is critical for you to understand what he is doing in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century.

**[ ] Church & Ministry Planting — PM 206 (1.5 Credits)**

Term 2, Monday Night Brisbane (7:00-8:00pm), 8 weeks (begins 11 Apr)

Today, God is planting new wineskin churches and ministries that reflect his heart. This subject will equip the students to be a part of this new work that God is doing. It will give you the tools you need to plant new churches and ministries, as well as partner with teams that are called to pioneer. We will not be learning human systems, but the patterns given in Scripture. These sessions will build on what is learned in the *Prophetic People* and *Apostolic Church* subjects.

**[ ] Taking it to the Streets – PM 202 (1.5 credits)**

Term 2, Monday Night Brisbane (8:15-9:15pm), 8 weeks (begins 11 Apr)

The best way to learn evangelism is to do it. And that is what we are going to do. Join with us as we take the Gospel to the streets. There will some instruction to prepare you, but mostly we will learn on the job. Emphasis will be on what the Holy Spirit is teaching us today about evangelism.

**Logan Campus [Kingdom Life Centre - 3922 Mt. Lindsay Hwy, Park Ridge] Subjects:**

**[ ] The Father Heart of God – TH 202 (1.5 credits)**

Term 1, Thursday Night Logan (7:00-7:50pm), 8 weeks (begins 3 Feb)

Many of our lives are broken because we do not know the Father's love toward us. Travel with us into the Father's heart. Discover his deep love and affection for you. This subject will emphasize experiencing his love and soaking in his presence.

**[ ] The Ministry & Message of the Apostles – NT 203-204 (3 credits)**

Term 1 & 2, Thursday Night Logan (8:10-9:00pm), 16 weeks (begins 3 Feb)

The early church devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching (Acts 2:42). We will do the same. This is the last part of our New Testament Studies. We will concentrate on the ministry and message of the apostles through reading the Epistles and Revelation. After completing this subject you will have a very well rounded understanding of the Bible and be able to see the big picture of God's story. "Even so come Lord Jesus!"

**[ ] Healing the Sick & Raising the Dead – PM 204 (1.5 credits)**

Term 2, Thursday Night Logan (7:00-7:50pm), 8 weeks (begins 14 Apr)

The title of this subject sums it up. We will study what the Bible teaches about healing the sick and raising the dead. Moreover, we will endeavour to put it into practice. Jesus said, "As you go, proclaim this message: 'The kingdom of heaven has come near.' Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse those who have leprosy, drive out demons" (Matt. 10:7-8). The Bible will be our manual and the streets will be our field. Come join us as we live out Jesus' commands.
